### Cameroon Seed School

The first school began in 2005 in Kumba, Cameroon. Cameroon has a relatively stable political situation and abundant food. We also have a personal connection through John Eta, a founding member of the charity who was born and raised in Cameroon. Through his family connection we have a unique opportunity to inject funding into the local community, to monitor how money is spent and to oversee the progress of our students.

#### Mandate

Our primary purpose is to operate schools for bright students and fast learners. We provide books, computers, classroom materials, teacher training and school buildings and facilities until each school can operate independently. Eta College schools will produce future African Leaders capable of addressing African problems and who are capable of social interest and ethical behaviour. Students selected for Eta Colleges are prepared for university entrance.

## **High Expectations**

There is a rigorous qualifying process to attend Eta College. Only students with the strongest abilities and families with the strongest commitment gain entrance. Achievement standards must be maintained to stay enrolled and there is an expectation of 8 A's and 2 B's for every 10 subjects.

# Leadership

Leadership is developed through student participation in community outreach programs and a teaching strategy which develops responsibility for one's own learning.

### Commitment

The quality of excellence and commitment is validated when 100% of school oversight and charity overhead have been done pro bono by passionate and committed professionals and volunteers. A 100% commitment to help our students succeed is evidenced by regular oversight visits by charity personnel and ongoing communications with teachers, staff, parents and students.

## Safety

100% of school construction meets the same high expectations that we would have for our own students here in Canada.









## Sustainability

Our goal is to have each school become 100% financially self-supporting. Monthly reporting ensures a learning opportunity for the school administration and compliance to budgets and fiscal management. The charity provides capital investment to build schools and to operate them until independent. Parents of students are required to pay tuition, transportation, text books and lunch for their children.

### Future Growth

Our biggest challenge is to place the right teachers in our classrooms. Mr. John Eta spends time every week communicating with the Principal and teachers of Eta College – Kumba, Benesure Campus to ensure quality educational performance. We continue to develop a team of educators who extend their influence to teachers in other schools in the community. As we continue to build our school we also plan to extend our educational reach to the primary levels in Kumba, Cameroon.
